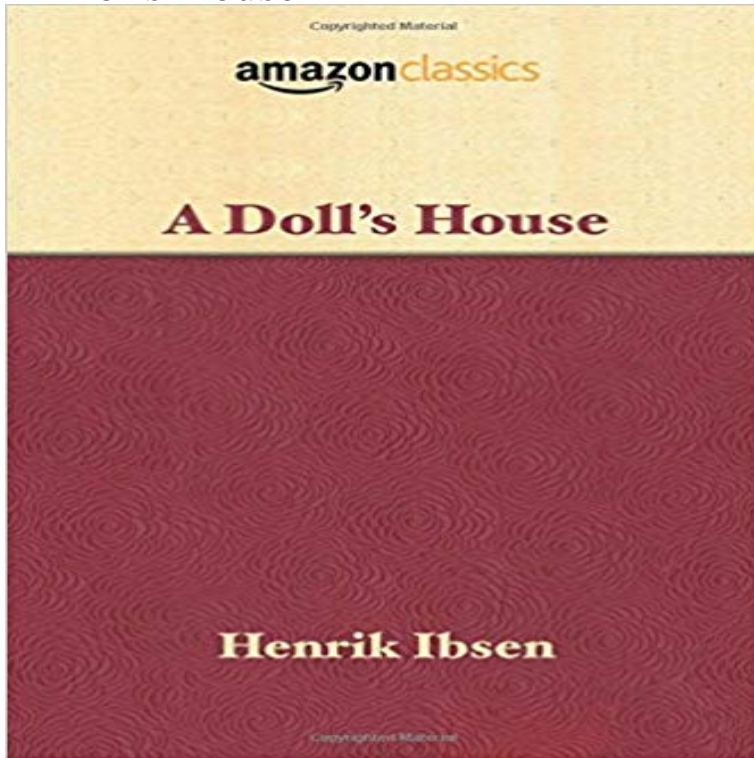


A Dolls House



The three-act play in prose by Henrik Ibsen, *A Dolls House* premiered at the Royal Theatre in Copenhagen, Denmark on 21 December 1879, and was published earlier that month. The play questions the traditional roles of men and women in 19th-century marriage. To many 19th-century Europeans, this was scandalous. Initially criticized, the play was later acclaimed as one of the finest works celebrating the rights of the women. In 2006, the centennial of Ibsen's death, *A Dolls House* held the distinction of being the world's most performed play for that year.
