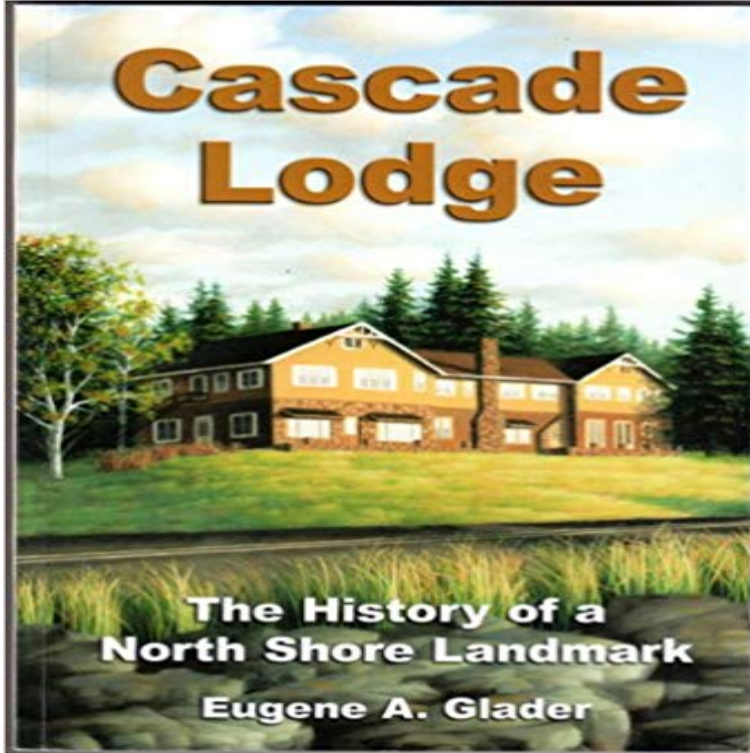


# Cascade Lodge : The History of a North Shore Landmark
