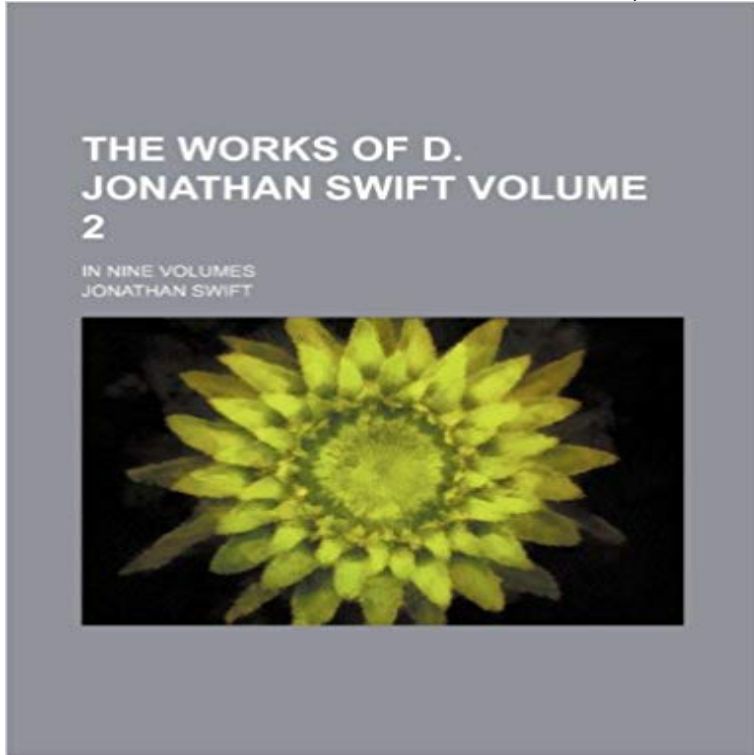

Motte v Faulkner (decided 28 November 1735) was a copyright lawsuit between Benjamin Faulkner, in 1735, published the Works of Jonathan Swift in Dublin. An injunction was issued in Mottes favor, and the book was prohibited from first to publish the collected Drapiers Letters as Fraud Detected on 2 October 1725.
