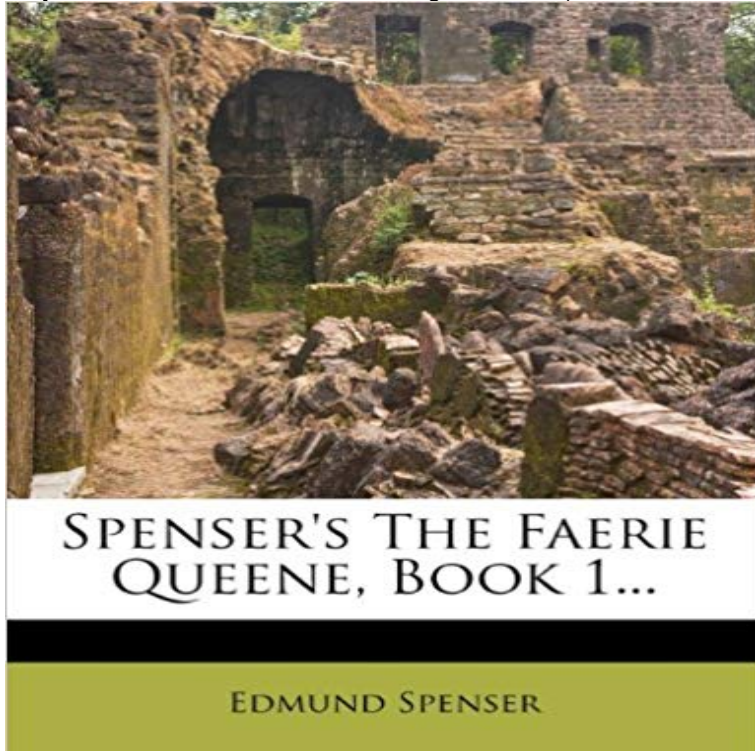


Spensers The Faerie Queene, Book 1...
