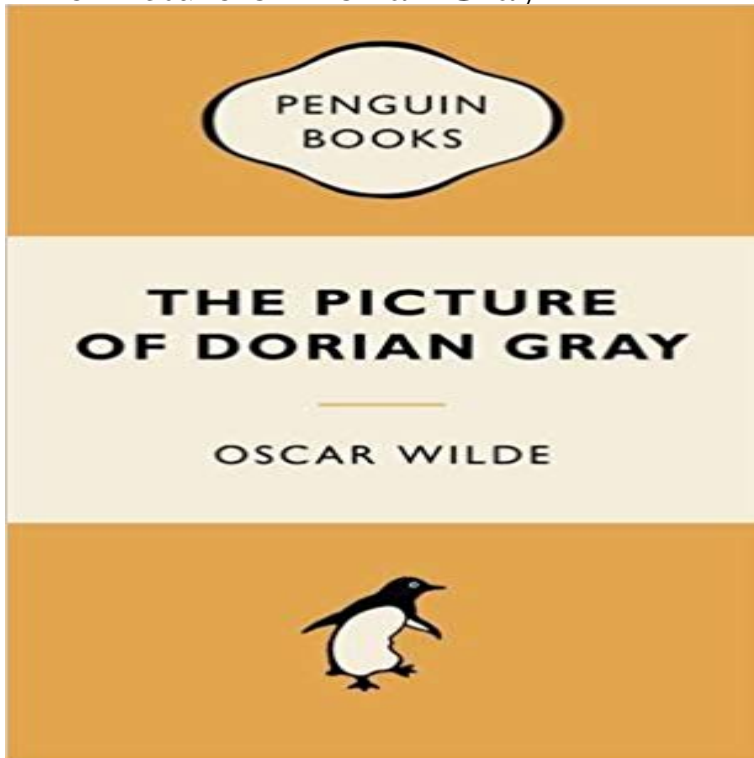


# The Picture of Dorian Gray
