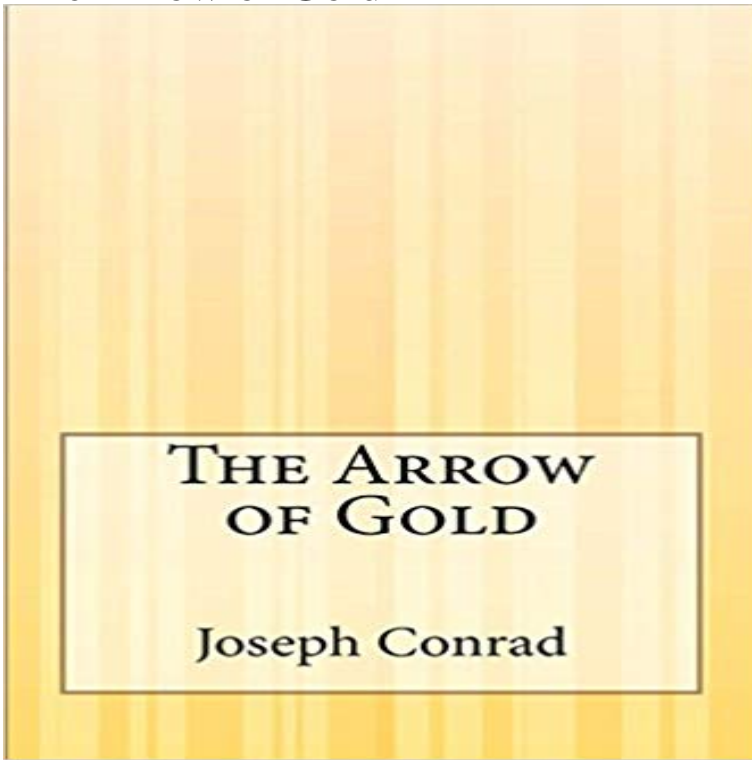


The Arrow of Gold
