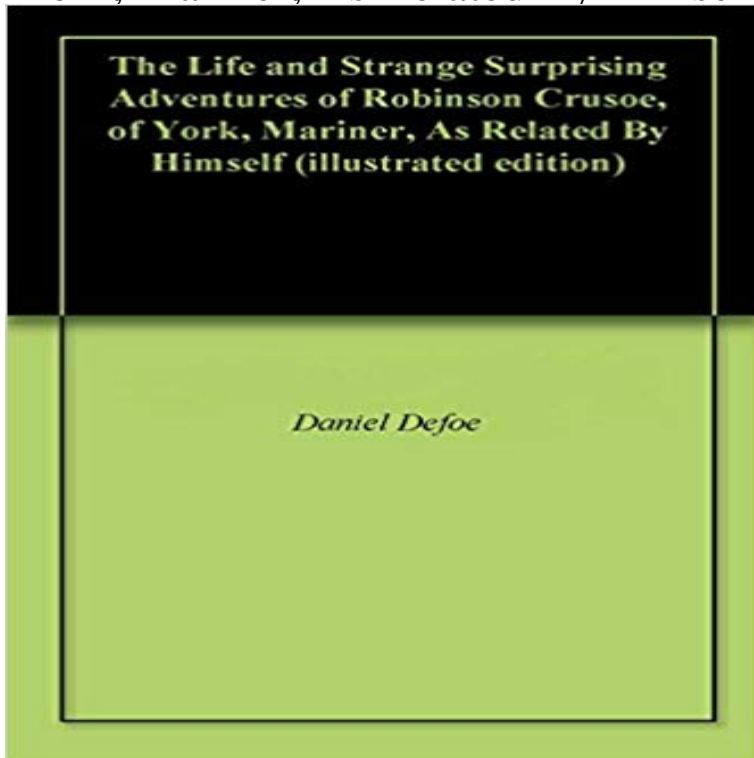


The Life and Strange Surprising Adventures of Robinson Crusoe, of York, Mariner, As Related By Himself (illustrated edition)
