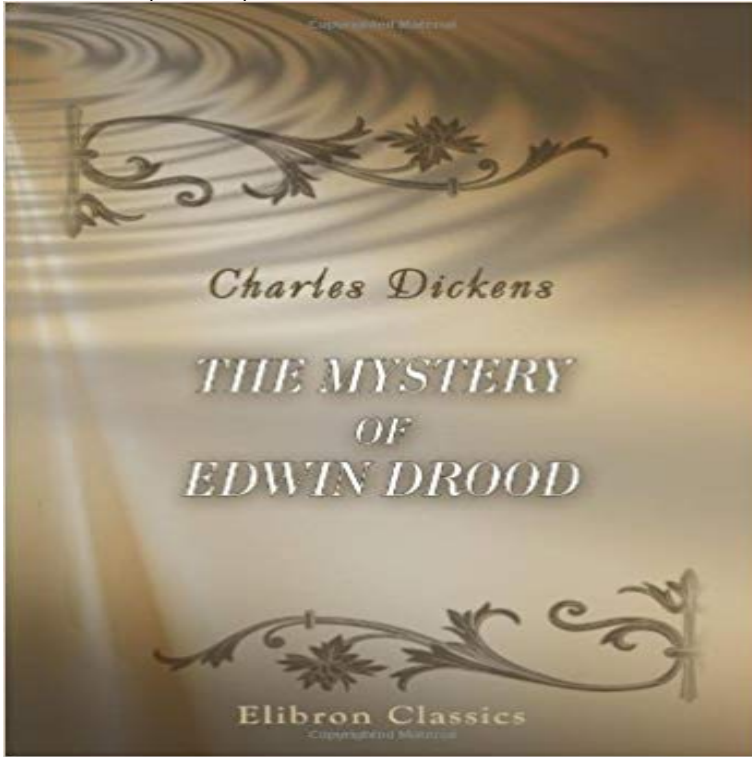


# The Mystery of Edwin Drood

Even without the solution, however, the novel is very much worth reading for its brilliant portrayal of the sociopathic choirmaster John Jasper and the marvellous wit with which Dickens depicts life in rural Cloisterham.
