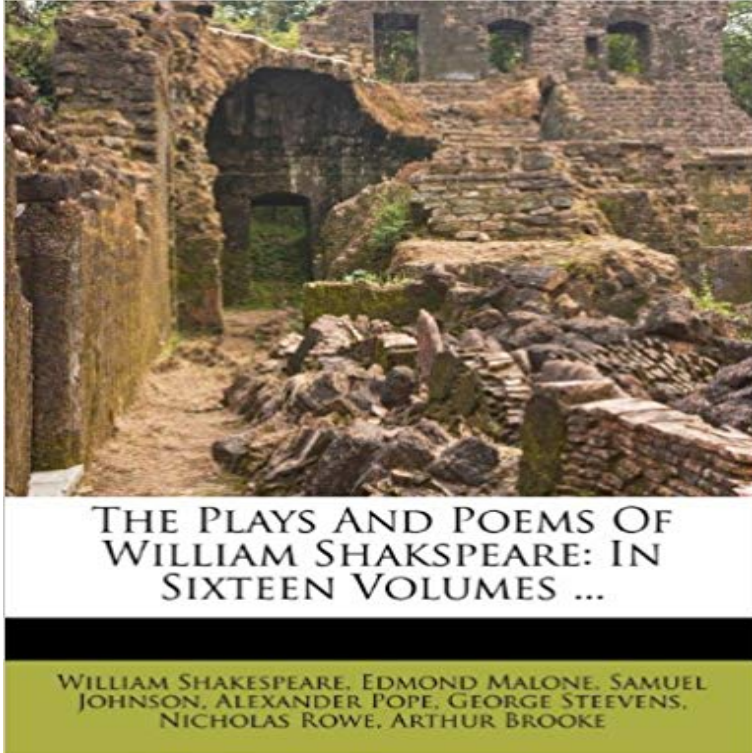


# The Plays And Poems Of William Shakspeare: In Sixteen Volumes ...
