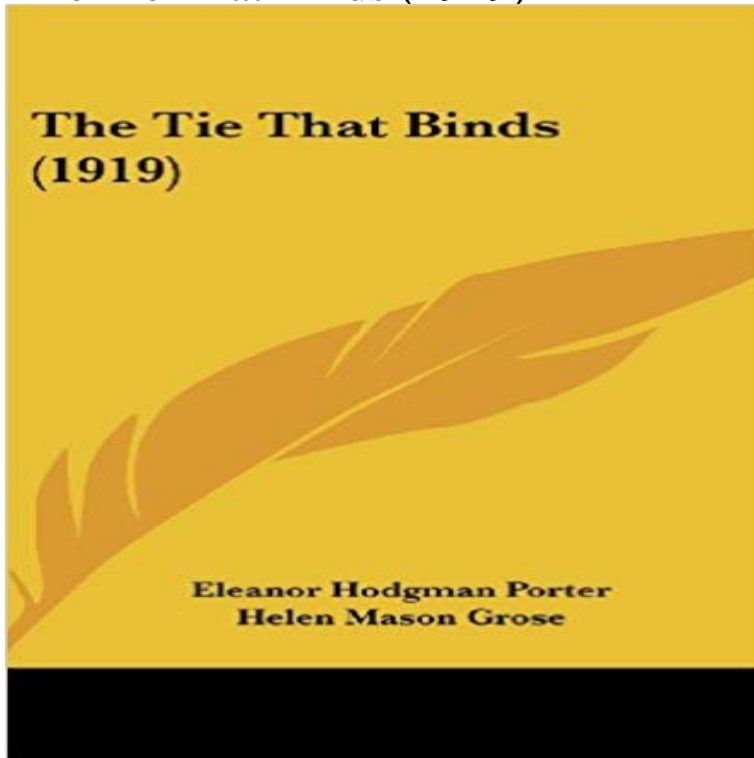


## The Tie That Binds (1919)
