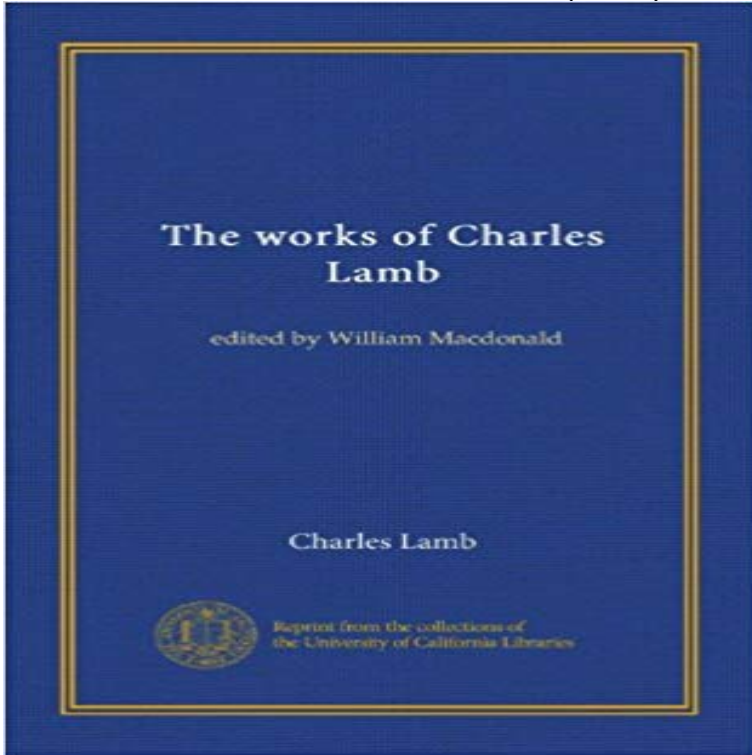


The works of Charles Lamb (v. 1): edited by William Macdonald
